




MONSTER FLIP BOOK

With this low-prep activity, students can color several mojos and trade them with classmates to see how much more we create when we work together!


PREPARATION

- What do you need?
 - Instruction sheet
 - Three or more monsters for each student
 - Coloring supplies
 - Scissors
 - Stapler














ACTIVITY

- Pass out the same number of monster templates to each student and give them time to color. Tell them to get creative! Add horns, tails, polka dots, sunglasses, anything they want! Instruct them to try to make their mojos as similar to each other as possible so they have duplicates of their monster.
- When students are finished coloring, have them keep one monster and exchange all of their other monsters with other students.
- Staple each of the books for students so that the monsters are aligned
- 4 Have student cut along the dotted lines to create a mix-and-match monster flip book.
- Give students a few minutes to flip through and create different fun combinations.

 Let them show each other their favorite combinations.
- 6 Lead a short discussion at the end of class. Ask students if they would have had as many combinations if they had kept all of their own original monsters. Did any of the monsters they got in exchange have fun features they didn't include in their own?
- **7** Reflect with students on how we get fresh, fun ideas when we work together.
